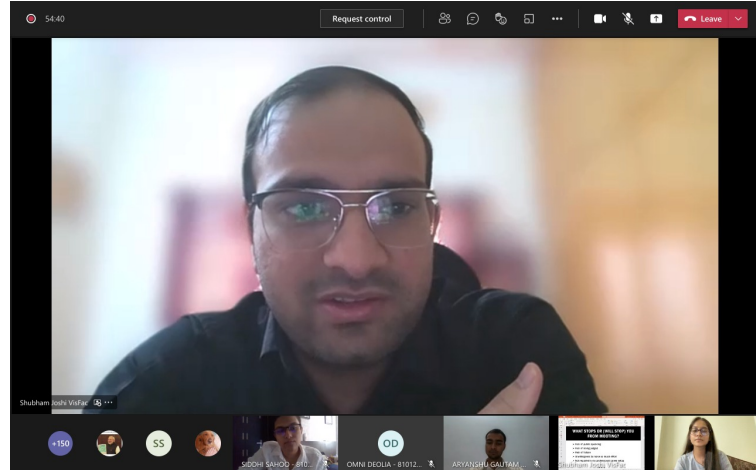

The Workshop was moderated by the members of the Moot Committee to make sure that any technical difficulty would be swiftly taken care of.

Adv. Shubham Joshi had made sure to give students a new direction in the Art of Mooting. He spoke on how to gain confidence by acquiring as much information as you can, how to level up your understanding of the moot problem and put forward creative solutions as well as how to Gain expertise in research, writing, and practice necessary to prepare professional solutions to moot problems. He also gave real-world trending examples to explain the topics and made sure to relate to the students in any way that he could.
